SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance by the City of Denton authorizing the City Manager to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with Denton County, Texas providing for the additional 2022 Denton County Transportation Road Improvement Program (TRIP 2022) reimbursement funding for the City's Bonnie Brae Phase 3 Widening and Reconstruction Project, in an amount not to exceed Four Million and NO/100 (\$4,000,000.00) Dollars; authorizing the expenditure of funds not to exceed Four Million and NO/100 (\$4,000,000.00) Dollars (Project Total \$6,851,785.00); and providing an effective date.

BACKGROUND

The South Bonnie Brae Widening and Reconstruction Project, funded from Regional Toll Revenue (RTR), TRIP 08 County Bond, and City funds totaling \$66,028,260.00, began design in 2010 with completion of construction phase 1 (bridge section on new alignment between Roselawn Drive and Vintage Boulevard) in 2021; and completion of construction phase 2 (Vintage Boulevard between Hwy 377 and I-35W) in 2022 had a combined completion cost of nearly \$41,000,000.00.

Phase 3 is the final phase in the South Bonnie Brae Widening and Reconstruction Project (Roselawn Drive to FM 1515 – I-35E). On Aug. 15, 2023, Council awarded the construction contract for Phase 3 in the amount of \$40,318,845.47 to Sundt Construction, and has since authorized change orders totaling \$3,798.899.16, for a total contract amount of \$42,197,899.61, and a current authorized spend amount of \$42,707,207.63.

On Nov. 8, 2022, voters approved the Denton County Transportation Road Improvement Bond Program Package (TRIP 2022), which includes project #12; Strategic Projects, County Judge in the amount of \$25,000,000.00 and project #88, Bonnie Brae Phase 4B (I-35E to Scripture) with a bond contribution in the not-to-exceed amount of \$7,100,000.00 toward the completion of the project.

The initial contribution of \$2,851,785.00, of which \$851,785.00 is TRIP 08 funding remaining from Bonnie Brae Phase 2; and \$2,000,000.00 from TRIP 2022, project #88, Bonnie Brae Phase 4B, both provided by the County Commissioner Precinct 4, has assisted with construction of the project.

This Amendment No. 1 to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (ICA) in the amount of \$4,000,000.00 from TRIP 2022, project #12; Strategic Projects, County Judge will also be used for construction.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW (COUNCIL, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS)

On Aug. 15, 2023, City Council approved the Construction Contract Sundt Construction, Inc., for the Bonnie Brae Phase 3 Widening and Reconstruction Project for the Capital Projects Department, in a not- to-exceed amount of \$40,318,845.47 (Ordinance 23-1524)

On Sept. 19, 2023, City Council authorized an ICA in the amount of \$2,851,785.00 with Denton County (Ordinance 23-1686)

On Apr. 15, 2025, City Council authorized change order #3 with Sundt Construction (Ordinance 25-640)

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of Amendment No. 1 to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (Ordinance 23-1686) to accept the reimbursement funding of \$4,000,000 for the Bonnie Brae Phase 3 Widening and Reconstruction Project.

ESTIMATED SCHEDULE OF PROJECT

Construction is ongoing and expected to be completed in November 2026.

FISCAL INFORMATION

An account will be established for the County Reimbursement Funding, and expenses will be moved accordingly.
