SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton approving and authorizing the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with the City of Lewisville, Texas, for the transfer to Lewisville of its share (\$21,798) of the proceeds of the U.S. Department of Justice – Office of Justice Programs – Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG Grant) 2022; and declaring an effective date.

STRATEGIC ALIGNMENT

This action supports Key Focus Area: Support Healthy and Safe Communities.

BACKGROUND

The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) Edward Byrne JAG program is a formula-based allocation grant, providing specific amounts to States and localities based on their resident population reported by the U.S. Census Bureau and on violent crime data reported to the Federal Bureau of Investigation’s Uniform Crime Reporting Program. The purpose of the grant is to further the DOJ’s mission by assisting state, local, and tribal jurisdictions’ efforts to prevent or reduce crime and violence and to improve the fair administration of the justice system. The 2022 JAG grant allocated the following amounts to entities in Denton County:

- a. City of Denton: \$32,201
- b. City of Lewisville: \$21,798
- c. Denton County: No amount was specified as Denton County did not submit the level of violent crime data to qualify for a direct award from the Bureau of Justice Assistance (“BJA”)

The City of Denton applied for and was awarded the allocated amount of \$32,201. The City also received the allocated funds for the City of Lewisville for a total of \$53,999, because they did not apply. Under the grant guidelines, counties and local jurisdictions must partner in the use of funds when receiving the grant. The JAG Grant funds awarded will be distributed through an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with each of the eligible cities in accordance with the JAG Grant provisions.

The Interlocal Cooperation Agreement was signed by the City of Lewisville’s City Manager on December 2, 2024.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of the ordinance.

FISCAL INFORMATION

The grant requires no funding match.
