AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (USDOT) BUILD AMERICA BUREAU'S FY 2024 REGIONAL INFRASTRUCTURE ACCELERATOR PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000,000 TO IMPLEMENT AN INTELLIGENT VERTIPORT TRAFFIC FLOW MANAGEMENT SYSTEM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) Build America Bureau issued a notice of funding opportunity on May 8, 2025, for entities to apply for funding assistance through the FY 2024 Regional Infrastructure Accelerator (RIA) Program; and

WHEREAS, the RIA program intent is to assist entities in increasing their capacity to deliver Transportation Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act (TIFIA) eligible projects in project planning, studies and analysis, revenue forecasting, preliminary engineering and design work, statutory and regulatory compliance analysis, assessment of opportunities for private financing, and other direct project specific support; and

WHEREAS, the RIA Program does not require a local match; and

WHEREAS, the City of Denton is eligible to apply for the funds under the application criteria; and

WHEREAS, the City has developed the necessary application materials and submitted an application on the June 16, 2025, due date to the USDOT FY 2024 RIA Program; NOW THEREFORE,

## THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The recitals set forth above are found to be true and correct legislative and factual determinations of the City of Denton and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Ordinance and made a part hereof for all purposes as if fully set forth herein.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The application for the USDOT FY 2024 Program in the amount of \$2,000,000 to implement an intelligent vertiport traffic flow management system is hereby ratified.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or designee, is designated, delegated, and authorized to request grant funding under the USDOT FY 2024 RIA Program, including the submission of USDOT's application, and act on behalf of the City of Denton in all matters related to the grant application, receipt of funds, and any subsequent grant contracts and grant projects that may result.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Should the project be funded, then the City of Denton shall comply with the requirements of the USDOT.

SECTION 5. The City of Denton supports funding this project as described in the USDOT FY 2024 RIA Application and is willing to commit to the project's development, implementation, construction, maintenance, management, and financing.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> The City of Denton is willing and able to enter into an agreement with USDOT should the project be selected for funding.

<u>SECTION 7.</u> The project funds and any project-funded equipment and facilities will be used solely for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant.

<u>SECTION 8.</u> This ordinance is effective immediately upon its passage.
