2. CONSENT AGENDA

Staff recommends approval of the following items because they meet the requirements of the Denton Development Code. A. PP17-0012

Consider a request by Texas Blue Horseshoe Ltd for approval of a Preliminary Plat of Lots 1, 2, and 3, Block A, of the Duluth Trading Co. - Northern Tool Addition. The approximately 18.01 acre site is generally located on the west side of the I-35 service road approximately 1,000 feet south of West University Drive. 4. PUBLIC HEARINGS
