

ID 22-469

Background

- Result of a one-minute pitch from Councilmember Byrd in September 2021
- Presented to City Council on February 1, 2022
- <u>City Council Direction</u>:
 - Primary Funding Source = City
 - Provide a sign allowance and if eligible neighborhoods want to exceed that allowance, then the eligible neighborhoods shall pay the difference




Proposed Annual Budget

- Breakdown of the Annual Budget (overseen by Traffic & Operations Department)
 - 10 neighborhoods* per year
 - 25 signs per neighborhood (maximum)
 - Opportunity to hold over extra signs with Operations Team in case of future theft or accidents

Material and Labor Costs

Signs (Fabricated by Centerline Supply Inc.)	\$85.00	1	
Bracket (City Supplied)	\$20.00	= \$105.00 (sign + bracket)	
Labor and Equipment	Approx. \$25/hour		

Annual Budget Costs Breakdown




Design Standards

• <u>Street Sign Topper Design Standards</u>


4/5/2022

- Size/Shape: (see 'Diagram Examples')
- Font Size: Should range between 2-3" and must be clearly visible from the street.
- **Reflectivity Standards:** Signs will need to be reflective, and sign background and content must contrast.
- Graphics: The City of Denton will only allow one graphic per neighborhood.
- Background color: Dark grey, dark red, dark green, dark blue, light brown, dark brown, black and white.



NOTE: Sign background and lettering shall be minimum ASTM Type I retro-reflective materials.

Font/Logo Dimensions





City Council Direction

- Direction from City Council regarding:
 - 1. Staff proposes the Street Sign Topper Program Annual Budget:
 - i. Annual budget of \$30,000;
 - ii. Maximum 10 neighborhoods per year; and
 - iii. Maximum 25 signs granted a year per neighborhood; and
 - iv. If the neighborhood wishes to exceed the maximum 25 signs allotted to them, additional signs will be paid for by the neighborhood.
