- Budget: \$50,000 total

- Status: Complete
- Issue: "Challenger" is painted black and blends in too much with the background. Recommendation is to repaint with lighter color.





• Budget: \$25,000


Subcommittee: Nichelson & Nuchols

Next steps: Call for artists, art submission review and PAC approval

Bonnie Brae Roundabout Sculpture

- Location: Roundabout at Bonnie Brae St. and Scripture St.
- Budget: \$133,020 (\$79,010 PAC/Bond and \$54,010 HOT)
- Subcommittee: Lane, Buie, and Liechty
- Status: Construction of roundabout improvements and art fabrication
- Next steps:
 - Artist completes fabrication and installation (estimated August 2022)



Bonnie Brae Roundabout Sculpture "Dog Star"






Traffic Box Wraps

- Status: Awaiting grant approval
