

Risk Management Budget Amendment



FY 2021-22 Risk Proposed Budget Amendment

- The proposed budget amendment will increase the expenditure budget for the Risk Fund by \$3 million from \$6,178,534 to \$9,178,534.
- Current expenditures for this fiscal year are at \$6,059,176 representing 98% of the adopted budget amount of \$6,178,534 with 2 months remaining in the fiscal year.
- The major items driving the additional expenses include:
 - Workers' Compensation Claims
 - Property Damage Claims
 - Insurance Policy Increases
