AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON APPROVING A CITY CO-SPONSORSHIP IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,615.66 OF IN-KIND SERVICES AND RESOURCES FOR THE ARTS & AUTOS EXTRAVAGANZA EVENT HOSTED BY THE DENTON MAIN STREET ASSOCIATION, WHICH WILL BE HELD ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 2022, FROM 9:00 A.M. TO 3:00 P.M., AT THE DENTON DOWNTOWN SQUARE, 110 W. HICKORY ST; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Denton Main Street Association is requesting the City Council of the City of Denton to participate as a co-sponsor for in-kind services and resources for the 23<sup>rd</sup> Annual Arts and Autos Extravaganza (“the Event”), which will be held on Saturday, September 10, 2022, at the Denton Downtown Square; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Arts and Autos Extravaganza is to provide local and visiting artists the opportunity to participate in the event, as well as attract car/truck/motorcycle and art enthusiasts, as well as increase contribution to the local economy by dining and shopping with local businesses while attendees are downtown for the show.

WHEREAS, the City of Denton will co-sponsor up to \$5,615.66 of in-kind services and resources for the event, which will include police security and solid waste and recycling services; and

WHEREAS, in exchange for support, the City of Denton will be considered an event cosponsor of the Arts and Autos Extravaganza at a co-sponsorship level equal to the total value of the co-sponsorship provided herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Denton finds that the co-sponsorship of the Arts and Autos Extravaganza serves a municipal and public purpose and is in the public’s interest; NOW THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Denton finds it is in the public’s interest and benefits the citizens of the City of Denton to participate as a co-sponsor at a level not to exceed \$5,615.66 for in-kind services and resources which includes police security, which will be held on Saturday, September 10, 2022, at the Downtown Square at 9:00 a.m. and that said participation as a co-sponsor is hereby ratified and approved.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
