SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, Texas, amending the fiscal year 2021-2022 budget and annual program of services of the City of Denton to allow for adjustments to the Materials Management Fund of six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) for the purpose of funding inventory for Denton Municipal Electric and to accommodate supply chain and demand challenges; declaring a public purpose; directing the City Secretary attach a copy to the 2021-2022 budget; requiring approval by at least five votes; and providing a severability clause, an open meetings clause, and an effective date.

BACKGROUND

City staff is proposing to amend the City's FY 2021-2022 Materials Management Fund budget as follows:

Increase appropriations in the Materials Management Fund by \$650,000 for the purposes of:

- Stocking inventory for Denton Municipal Electric to maintain current assets and deliver on development projects. Most affected items include:
 - o Transformers
 - o Primary/secondary cable and wire
 - o PVC conduits and fittings
- Supply chain and demand challenges
 - o Increased pricing due to low commodity inventory and high demand
 - o Increased lead times on receiving equipment and supplies

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the adoption of the ordinance.

FISCAL INFORMATION

This ordinance will amend the FY 2021-2022 Budget and Annual Program of Services to allow for an increase to the Materials Management Fund by \$650,000.
