SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the Regular and Special Municipal Elections held on May 6, 2023; declaring that a runoff election is not necessary; and providing an effective date.

BACKGROUND

Adoption of this ordinance will formally canvass the election returns of the regular and special elections for council members in Districts 1, 2, 3, and 4, and Proposition A, held on May 6, 2023.

The Unofficial Results are attached as Exhibit A to the ordinance. These results show all successful candidates for District 1, District 2 (unopposed), District 3 and District 4 received a majority of the votes cast. As a result, a runoff election is not necessary. These results also show Proposition A received a majority of the votes cast. As a result, Council Member Jesse Davis shall be removed from the District 3 Seat of the City Council by Recall.

Monday, May 15, 2023, is the last day for the Early Voting Ballot Board to convene and qualify/count provisional ballots, overseas ballots, as well as mail in ballots postmarked by 5 p.m. on Monday, May 8. While minor revisions could result to the unofficial results reported on May 8, the outcome of the election is not anticipated to change. A revised ordinance/exhibit will be provided at (or shortly before) the meeting once received from Denton County Elections.
