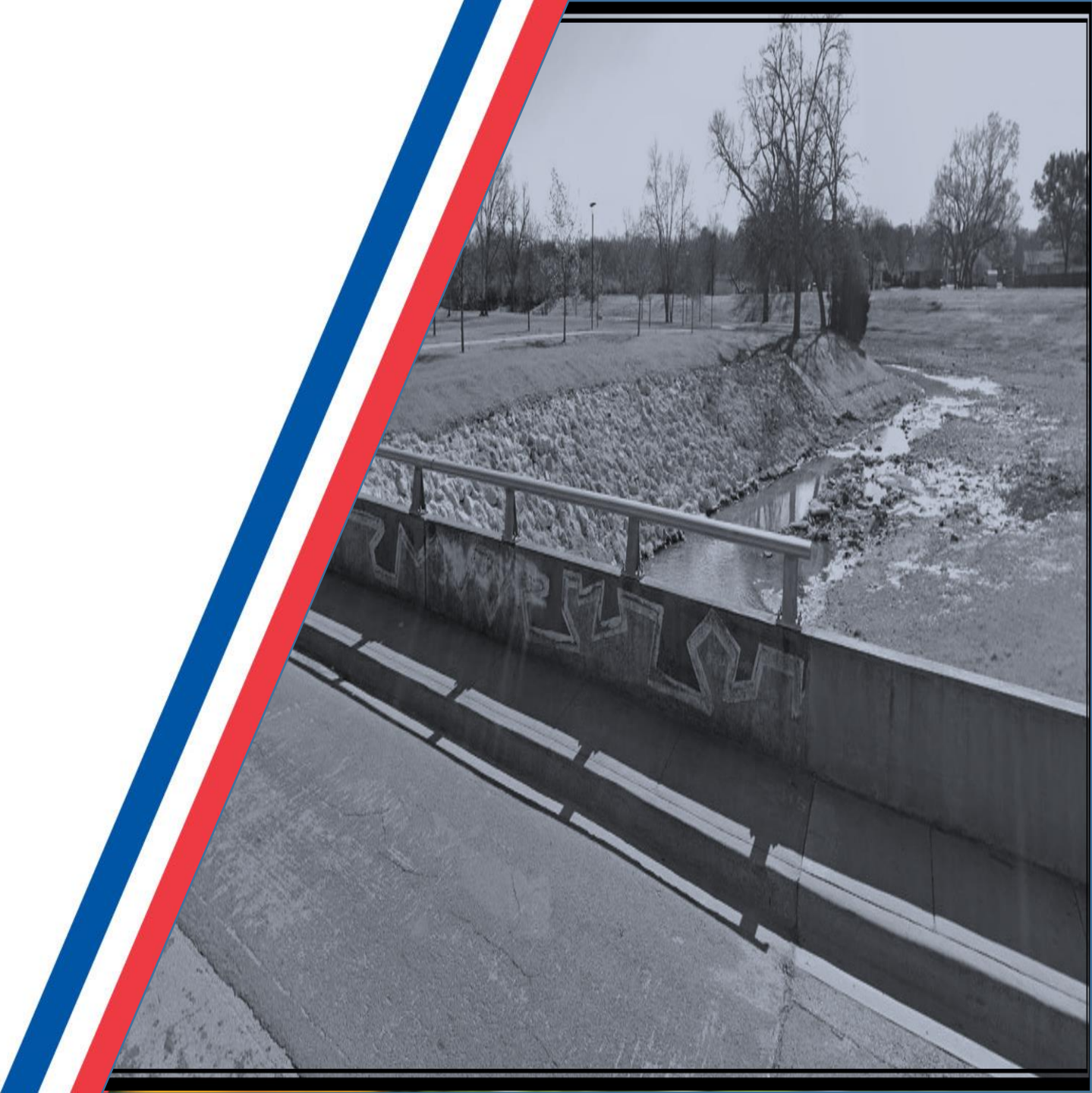




Sycamore Street Bridge

Overview

- Several community meetings including SEDNA and ALH
- Community suggested a theme of flowers/butterflies
- First scope/RFP closed 3/10/23 but did not include a budget
- Second scope/RFP closed 4/20/23 with budget of \$5,000-\$7,500
- Scope of work included prep work and three walls of the bridge
- Extensive outreach efforts

- Budget: \$25,000

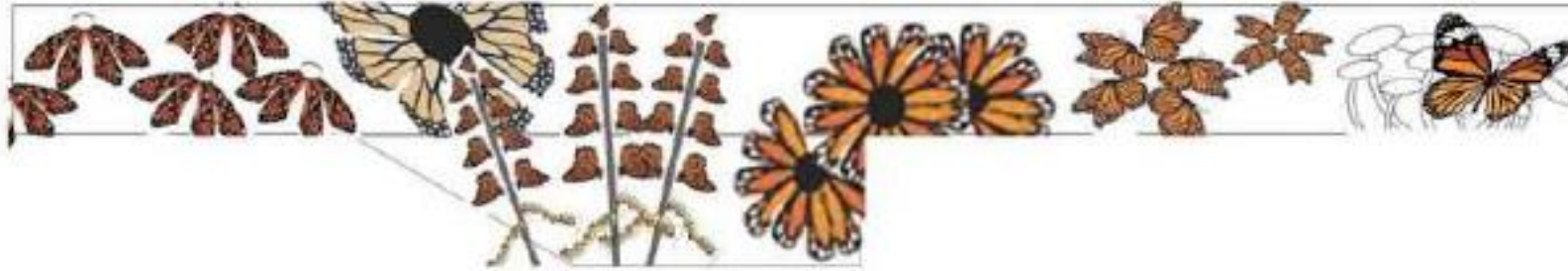


Christine Sanders

H2OScapes

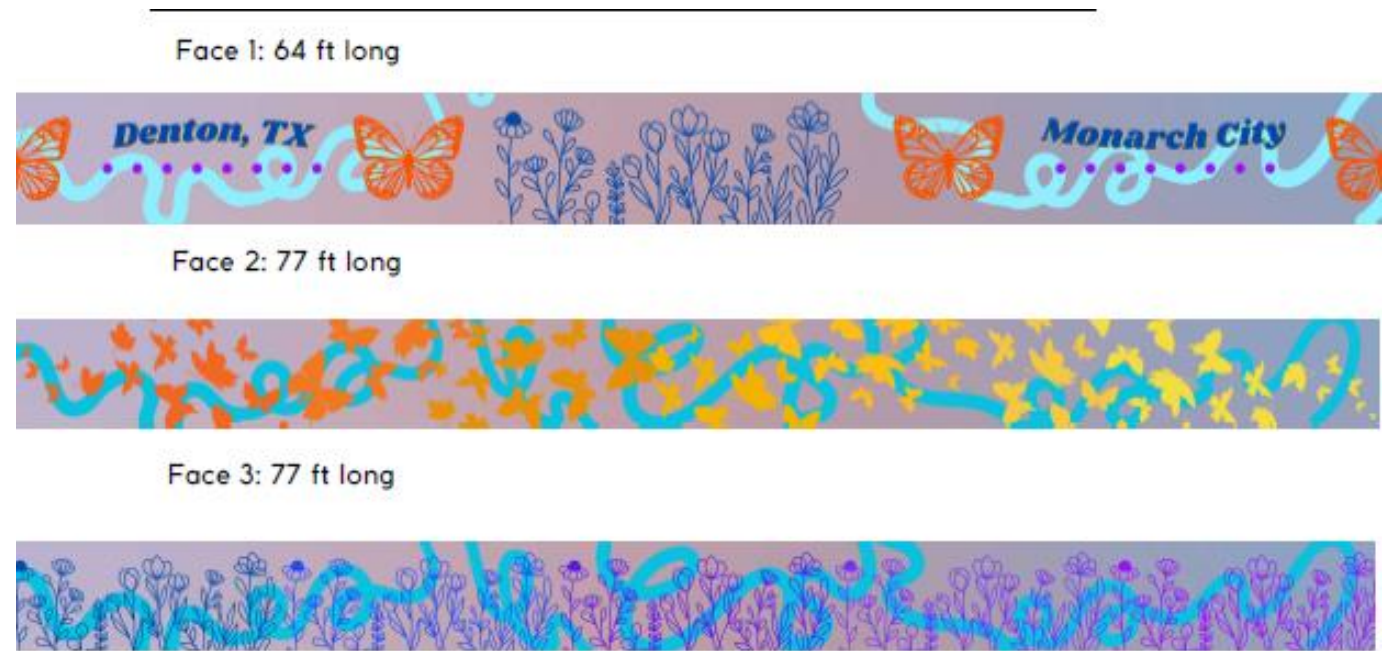


- Proposed the inclusion of two sculptures on either side of the bridge
- Painted mural between the low-relief sculptures of milkweed plants
- Budget: \$129,500

Paula Dosal-Terminel

(Omega Arts Projects)

- Proposal had a thorough understanding of material usage, prep work
- Vibrant design involving directly painted surface
- Budget: \$60,430



Per4mance Printing

- Installation of Vinyl Wrap
- Budget: \$16,135



Natasha May Platt

- Provided a written proposal
- Does not “present designs, sketches, or renderings until after receiving 50% of the project cost
- Budget: \$39,000
- Submitted a revised vinyl wrap budget of \$6500



Rhiana Deck

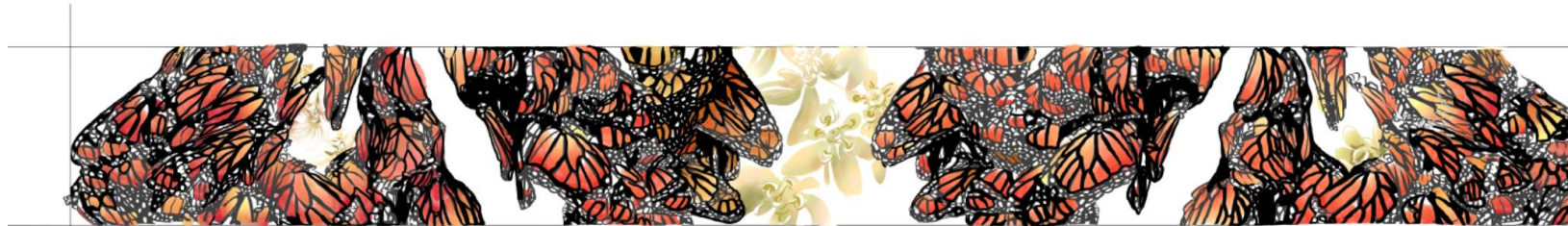
- Painted application
