#### **SUBJECT**

Consider adoption of an ordinance by the City of Denton ratifying and authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute and deliver an Advanced Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for bridge replacement or rehabilitation of the state system project located at Trinity Road at Cooper Creek in the City of Denton; Providing for the use of federal funds for a project of 100% funding with no local match required, in the amount of nine hundred seventy-three thousand and eighty-one dollars (\$973,081.00) for CSJ #0918-46-300; authorizing the expenditure of funds therefor; and providing an effective date.

#### **INFORMATION/BACKGROUND**

On November 2, 2021, the City of Denton ("City") and the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") entered into an Advance Funding Agreement ("AFA") regarding the replacement of the off-system bridge located at Trinity Road and Cooper Creek (CSJ 0918-46-300; herein referred to as the "Project").

Approve the Advanced Funding Agreement with TxDOT and provide an effective date.
