
Sec. 1-12. General penalty.

- (a) Where no specific penalty is provided for in this Code for a violation of a provision of this Code or where any provision of this Code or any ordinance provides for a maximum fine in the amount which is in conflict or inconsistent with the maximum fine provided for herein, the maximum fine shall be as follows:
- (1) Two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) for a violation of any provision governing fire safety, zoning or public health and sanitation, excluding vegetation and litter violations;
 - (2) Two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for a violation of any provision regulating the parking of motor vehicles, any provision enacted pursuant to Vernon's Ann. Civ. St. art. 6701d, ~~or any provision of chapter 6 of this Code;~~
 - (3) The amount fixed by state law if the provision is one for which state law establishes a fine;
 - ~~(4) Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for a violation of any provision of chapter 6 of this Code;~~
 - ~~(5)~~ Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for any other violation not otherwise provided for in this section.
- (b) A person violating a provision of this Code or other ordinance, rule or regulation of the city is guilty of a separate offense for each day or part of a day during which the violation is committed, continued or permitted, unless otherwise provided.
- (c) The provisions in this section are cumulative of all other remedies, including but not limited to injunctions and other extraordinary writs. This section shall govern all penalties for any violation of this Code, notwithstanding any language to the contrary contained in any other section of this Code.
