BACKGROUND – COUNCIL ACTIONS

- November 14, 2023: Council Member Watts made a two-minute pitch request and received support for work session to discuss the City creating Public Facility Corporations to develop affordable housing in the City of Denton, including a comprehensive analysis of the definition, creation, and administration of Public Facility Corporations. (ID 23-227).
- On <u>March 19th, 2024</u>, Council provided direction to staff to create a development program authorizing the formation of Public Facility Corporations for future affordable housing projects (<u>ID 23-2349</u>)

CREATING PFC



Step 1:

• Preparing Bylaws and Certificate of Formation

Step 2:

City Council Approval

ACTION: Approve the formation docs, appoint initial board members, and authorize submitting to SOS

Step 3:

Submission to the Secretary of State

Step 4:

• File for Franchise Tax Exemption and EIN

Step 5:

Organizational Meeting



TO APPROVE PFC

There are two actions necessary to complete the formation of the PFC.

- 1. Approval of the Resolution by City Council accepting the formation documents and approving submissions to the Secretary of State and necessary filings required to form the DPFC.
- 2. Approve the DPFC bylaws to be adopted by the initial board of directors.
