<u>SECTION 2.</u> The City of Denton hereby endorses and urges legislation to provide universal, comprehensive health care coverage with zero cost-sharing for patients by enacting the Medicare for All Act of 2021 to ensure appropriate health care coverage for all residents of the United States during this ongoing crisis, the crisis recovery period, and beyond.
