AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CITY SPONSORSHIP IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,500.00 OF IN-KIND SERVICES AND RESOURCES FOR THE DENTON COUNTY VETERANS COALITION'S STAND DOWN EVENT TO BE HELD IN THE CIVIC CENTER AND QUAKERTOWN PARK LOCATED AT 321 E.
