


## ACM UPDATE

The City Council Committee on the Environment requested an update on Electric Vehicle charging stations in the City of Denton. The City of Denton has 12 electric vehicle charging stations located at municipal facilities throughout the city. There are additional charging stations located on the UNT campus and at other locations throughout the City. The City of Denton Fleet Department is evaluating new electric vehicles for municipal use, if additional electric vehicles are added, charging stations could follow based upon vehicle location.
