- Single Lot
- NRMU zoning district



Co-housing

- Co-housing is a small intentional community
- The homes tend to be smaller in size
- Co-housing is designed for increased interaction with neighbors
- Common gathering areas such as a shared common house, community gardens, etc.





Options

- 1. Approve the project as part of an Overlay District
- 2. Amend the DDC to allow for Planned Development (PD) Districts and approve the project as part of a PD
- 3. Add a commercial land use in Subchapter 35.5 that would allow sleeping units as a component of the use
- 4. Amend the DDC to reduce the minimum floor area requirement for multi-family dwellings to 300 square feet

Overlay Districts

- Protect and enhance certain specific lands and structures which, by virtue of their type or location, have characteristics which are distinct from lands and structures outside such special districts
- The creation or amendments to an Overlay District shall be made using the Zoning Amendment Procedure
- Overlay Districts
 - Statement of Purpose
 - District Boundary
 - Regulations and Design Standards
