

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE RUNOFF MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF DENTON ON JUNE 10, 2017.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds and declares that the June 10, 2017 runoff municipal election was duly ordered for the purpose of electing a Council Member to District 3; that proper notice of said election was duly given and election officials appointed; that said election was duly held and the returns of the election officials have been delivered to the Council, all in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the Charter and ordinances of the City of Denton.

SECTION 2. The official returns of the election officials having been opened, examined and canvassed, the Council hereby finds and declares that _____ ballots were cast at said election, and that the votes cast for each place on the Council were as follows:
