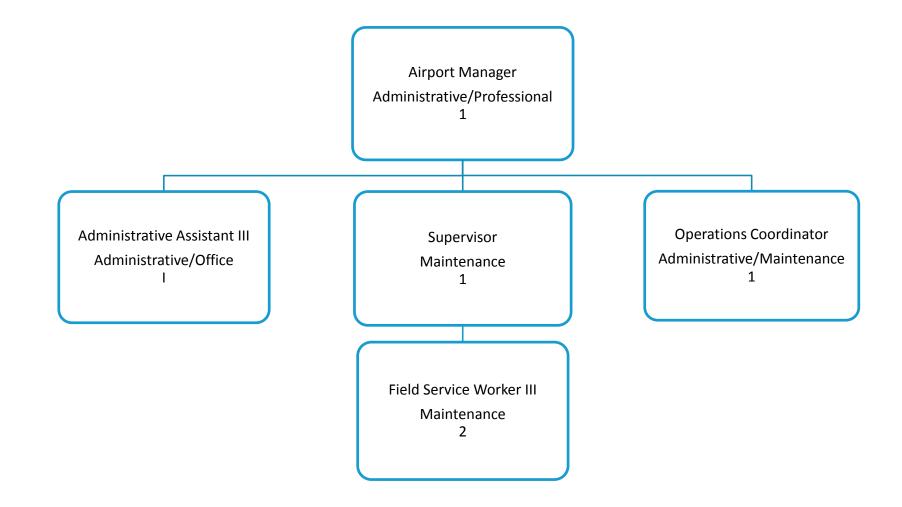

### Denton Enterprise Airport Goals and Accomplishments

#### **Accomplishments for 16-17:**

- 1. Substantially completed land acquisition for west parallel runway.
- 2. Finalized plans for west parallel runway.
- 3. Completed city hangar project- 27 individual hangars.
- 4. Generated 2.8 acres of new property leases.
- 5. Improved grounds maintenance/airfield operations procedures.

#### **Goals for 17-18:**

- 1. Enhance revenue options.
- 2. Complete construction of west parallel runway.
- 3. Attract 1 new aviation industry to Denton Enterprise Airport.
- 4. Receive grant for reconstruction of primary runway.
- 5. Revise/update business plan.

### Denton Enterprise Airport Cost Containment Strategies

#### **Summary of Department efforts:**

- 1. Staff restructuring of moving Director of Transportation over the Airport division is estimated to save \$82,000 annually.
- 2. The division has reassessed the CIP needs moving forward:
  - Planned extension of Spartan Dr. Removed from CIP due to the fact that it would decrease possible revenue by removing developmental space;
  - Proposed drainage project for John Carrell Rd. has been delayed to reassess scope
  - These changes have a net savings of \$200,000.
