24 A. Consider a request by R. Hilliard, D. Fulton, and Vandersmith Developers, LTD for approval
25 of a Preliminary Plat of Lots 1-4, Block A of CST 2809 Addition. The approximately 17.19 acre
26 site is generally located on the east side of the Country Club Road and Fort Worth Drive
27 intersection in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (PP17-0005, CST/Corner Store, Hayley
28 Zagurski).

30 B. Consider a request by Three Willows Land Development for approval of a Preliminary Plat of
31 Lot 1 and Lot 2, Block A, of Avalon of Denton Addition. The 6.81 acre site is located southeast
32 of the intersection of West Windsor Drive and I-35 Northbound Service Road, and west of Bray
33 Village Drive. (PP16-0014, Avalon of Denton, Muzaib Riaz).

35 C. Consider a request by Mark Peeples of Arthur Surveying for approval of a Final Plat of Lots 1,
36 2, and 3, Block A of Country Club Acres. The approximately 8.62 acre site is generally located
37 on the southeast side of Country Club Road and Brush Creek Road intersection in the
38 extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (FP17-0014, Country
39 Club Acres, Hayley Zagurski).

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2 4. PUBLIC HEARINGS
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4 A. Hold a public hearing and consider a request by Denton Independent School District for
5 approval of a final plat of Lot 6A-R, Block 4, of the Northside Addition; being a replat of Lots 6A
6 and 17-R, Block 4 of the Northside Addition and the abandoned Gary Street. The approximately
7 3.05 acre property is generally located at the southwest corner of East Third Street and North
8 Locust Street in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (FR17-0011, Northside Addition, Julie
9 Wyatt). THIS ITEM HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN BY THE APPLICANT.

11 Chair Strange stated Public Hearing item 4A had been withdrawn by the applicant.

13 B. Hold a public hearing and consider a request by Not Quite 4A Properties LP for a Specific Use
14 Permit to allow for a multi-family use on approximately 0.9 acres. The property is generally
15 located on the north side of the Riney Road and Riney Court intersection. This item has been
16 continued from the June 14, 2017, Planning and Zoning Commission Meeting. (S16-0007, Riney
17 Road Apartments, Hayley Zagurski).

19 Chair Strange opened the Public Hearing.

21 Chair Strange stated the applicant has requested for Public Hearing item 4B to be postponed until
22 the July 12, 2017 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting.
