Chuck sears answered this substation was approved on 11/2014 by City Council 32 and the wall after it was approved. Brian Daskam stated that City Council approved the site 33 and aesthetic wall. This was decided after the Eagle Substation had been decided on. Chair 34 Robinson stated that PUB did not vote for this site to be a GIS substation. Staff agreed, 35 this was decided by City Council. 36 37 Sears showed pictures of what the wall and substation will look like after the new unit is in 38 place. The overhead lines will be placed underground cleaning up that area drastically. 39 40 Board Member Parker motioned to approve this item. There was a second by Board 41 Member Bishop. Vote 4-0 approved, (Russell had stepped out).
