BACKGROUND

Staff would like to provide a brief update on some recent citizen engagement, communication, and transparency initiatives with the Committee on Citizen Engagement.

Citizen Engagement Programs:

- State of the City Event
 - o Held on March 30, 2017
 - Approximately 150 members of the public attended
 - Tables set-up allowing residents to visit with staff and council members about programs and opportunities to get involved in the City
 - o Ideas/Discussion for next year: Time of year, set a time for when Mayor's presentation will begin, shorten presentation and have more time for Q&A, have more seating and aisles
- Citizen's Academy
 - o Twelve citizens participated in the first academy this summer
 - Program consisted of 5 sessions:
 - Session 1 Mayor Welcome, Intro, Form of Government, Finance/Budget, Internal Auditor
 - Session 2 Emergency Management, Fire, Police, Legal, Municipal Court
 - Session 3 Airport, Development Services, Economic Development, Customer Service, Capital Projects
 - Session 4 Water/Wastewater Treatment Plants, Solid Waste and Landfill, Denton Municipal Electric
 - Session 5 Parks and Recreation tour, Environmental Services and Clear Creek Heritage Center, Libraries
 - o Ideas/Discussion for next year: Evaluate number of sessions and session length, use photos and feedback to market program and achieve higher enrollment (goal 20-25 people)
- New Idea "Open House" events

Communication Items Completed:

- Construction Portal and Map
- Informal Staff Reports Library
- Council Voting History
- Online Staff Directory

Communication Items In Progress or Planned:

- DTV to record 4 new Council Committees (beginning in August)
 - o Mobility Committee, Traffic Safety Commission, Economic Development Partnership Board, and Zoning Board of Adjustment
- Committee, Boards and Commissions Agendas and Minutes Library (early August)
- Newsletter (Q1 of FY17/18)
 - o Print working on a print newsletter that could be mailed out bi-monthly or quarterly
 - o Electronic looking at an online newsroom on the city's website or an e-newsletter
