Hiram Survey, Abstract 623 and the Alexander Hill Survey, Abstract 623, City of Denton, Denton County, Texas, and more particularly described on Exhibits “A,” “A-1,” “B-1,” “A-2,” “B-2,” “A-3,” “B-3,” “A-4,” “B-4,” “A-5,” “B-5,” “A-6,” “B-6,” “A-7,” “B-7,” “A-8,” and “B-8” to the ordinance now under consideration and on the overhead screen being now displayed to the audience, all of which is for a valid public use necessary to provide the expansion, construction, maintenance, operation, and improvement of electric transmission lines, facilities, and structures, including substations, to serve the public and citizens of the City of Denton, Texas.”
