(ID 17-945 Underwood Substation)

“I move that the City of Denton, after having made the offers required by State law, use the power of eminent domain, if needed, to acquire fee simple to the surface estate of a 10.129 acre tract generally located at the southeast corner of FM 2449 and Underwood Road, and being situated in the C.W. Byerly Survey, Abstract No. 1458, in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas, and to acquire a drainage easement in a 0.430 acre tract and a temporary construction easement in a 0.286 acre tract, both in the G. West Survey, Abstract No. 1393, all more particularly described on Exhibits “A,” “A-1,” “B-1,” “A-2,” and “B-2” to the ordinance now under consideration and on the overhead screen being now displayed to the audience, all of which is for a valid public use necessary to provide the expansion, construction, maintenance, operation, and improvement of electric transmission lines, facilities, and structures, including substations, to serve the public and citizens of the City of Denton, Texas.”
