### Background:

- Home Occupations is defined as an occupation commonly carried on within a
  dwelling by members of the family occupying the dwelling. The use of the
  home for an occupation shall be incidental and subordinate to the use of the
  home as a dwelling.
  - Permitted with conditions in several zoning districts
  - Require SUP approval as well
- Proposed Regulation:
  - Remove SUP requirement for music studios
    - Require compliance with use-specific standards to mitigate potential nuisances

## SUP Approvals:

- Used to evaluate applications for development and land uses that have a unique or widely varying operating characteristic or unusual feature.
- Intended to ensure compatibility with surrounding properties and to mitigate potential impacts.
- Since 2007, one application has been processed to allow for a home-based music studio; however, it was withdrawn by the applicant prior to City Council action.



- Current limitations on use:
  - General a home occupation permitted when it's an accessory use to a residential dwelling
  - Employees must be operated by the homeowner and no more than two employees that reside outside the home
  - Patrons no more than 4 at a time
  - Hours of Operation 8:00 am to 8:00 PM only
  - Product Display No external display of products
  - Outdoor storage and Activities none allowed relating to the business
  - Signage no advertisement on or off the premises
  - Product Sales permitted provided compliance with all other conditions in this section



- Current limitations on use (con't):
  - Prohibited Equipment and Materials No chemical, electrical equipment other than normally found within a dwelling unit
  - Nuisance no offensive noise, vibration, smoke, electrical interference, dirt, odors or heat in excess of those found normally in residential areas. No toxic, explosive, flammable, combustible, corrosive, radioactive, or other hazardous materials shall be used or stored on site. (was inadvertently removed on draft)
  - Parking and Business-Related Vehicles (Vehicles Marked or Equipped Commercially) No on-street parking by business related vehicles. No vehicles larger than a van, panel truck or pickup truck shall be permitted to park overnight on the premises.

- Summary
  - The proposed new regulations will remove the requirement for approval of an SUP for home-based music studios
  - Home based businesses will still be required to comply with use-specific standards to mitigate potential impacts which are currently being drafted for review and comment.
