SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, Texas setting the Energy Cost Adjustment (Schedule ECA) rate, Renewable Cost Adjustment (Schedule RCA) rate, and Transmission Cost Recovery Factor (Schedule TCRF) rate in accordance with terms and conditions of these rates as stated in the 2017 Electric Rate Service Schedule ordinance; providing for a repealer; providing for a severability clause; and providing an effective date. The PUB recommends approval (5-0).

BACKGROUND

The Energy Cost Adjustment (ECA), Renewable Cost Adjustment (RCA), and Transmission Cost Recovery Factor (TCRF) are electric rates that are approved separately from the electric rate book. While the rate book includes schedules that allow for the adoption of the ECA, RCA, and TCRF, the schedules do not include the rate itself. This is because the ECA, RCA, and TCRF schedules contain provisions that allow for a quarterly review and, when necessary, adjustment of these rates based on certain financial conditions.

When the rate book was presented for PUB consideration in July, staff informed the PUB of the recommended rate changes for ECA, RCA, and TCRF to achieve an average 1% decrease in rates. To achieve this 1% overall reduction, ECA and RCA will be decreased, while TCRF rates will be slightly increased.

Previously, the ECA, RCA, and TCRF were adopted directly by the PUB. However, upon direction from the Legal Department, staff is bringing forward this item to allow for formal adoption of the ECA, RCA, and TCRF by the City Council.

The proposed rates are as follows:

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>
On September 11th, the Public Utilities Board recommended approval of the proposed ECA, RCA, and TCRF rates.

ESTIMATED SCHEDULE OF PROJECT

If approved, the proposed rates go into effect on October 1, 2017.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW (Council, Boards, Commissions)

The Public Utilities Board recommended approval (5-0) on September 11, 2017 (PUB17-178).

FISCAL INFORMATION

The proposed electric rates represent a 1% decrease to the overall rates by means of a \$0.002/kWh decrease in the Energy Cost Adjustment (ECA) and Renewable Cost Adjustment (RCA) and a slight increase in the Transmission Cost Recovery Factor (TCRF).

STRATEGIC PLAN RELATIONSHIP
