# **SUBJECT**

Consider adoption of an ordinance accepting competitive proposals and awarding a contract for the purchase of traffic signal hardware including signal heads, backplates, tunnel visors, camera systems and cabinets for the City of Denton Traffic Division; providing for the expenditure of funds therefor; and providing an effective date (RFP 6357-awarded to multiple vendors for a total three (3) year amount not-to-exceed amount of \$1,326,093.12).

## **RFP INFORMATION**

Request for Proposals (RFP) were solicited for the purchase of traffic signal hardware including signal heads, backplates, tunnel visors, camera systems and cabinets for the City of Denton Traffic Division. These materials will be utilized in the construction of new signals and in the maintenance of the existing traffic control system throughout the City of Denton.

Requests for Proposals were sent to 256 prospective suppliers for these items. In addition, specifications were placed on the Materials Management website for prospective suppliers to download and advertised in the local newspaper. Eight (8) proposals were received. The proposals were evaluated based upon published criteria including performance, delivery, compliance with specifications, and price. A Best and Final Offer was solicited which resulted in the addition of one line item but no unit price changes. Staff recommends awarding by line item as shown on Exhibit 2 in order to obtain the best value. Items 1-6, 63,64,69,72-78,81-88 did not receive any responses and will not be awarded at this time.

# **RECOMMENDATION**

Award to the highest scored vendor for each line item in the three (3) year not-to-exceed amount of \$1,326,093.12.
