A. Parks and Recreation 2017/2018 Budget / Schedule of Fees

Christine Taylor, Business Manager, presented an overview of the 2017/2018 Parks and Recreation Budget and associated Schedule of Fees, as set forth below.

Included in the Schedule of Fees is a statement authorizing discounts for various promotions by Parks and Recreation.
