Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, Texas, granting the Singing Oaks Church of Christ, pursuant to Section 17-20 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Denton, Texas, an exception on Sunday, October 29, 2017, granting amplified sound not to exceed 65 dba from noon until 5 p.m. and setting an effective date.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Singing Oaks will host a Walk4Water event raising funds to drill water wells providing clean water for people in Africa and Haiti. Bob Bentley, event coordinator, requests an exception to the noise ordinance for amplified sound on Sunday, October 29, 2017, not to exceed 65 dba. Walk4Water will be held in South Lakes Park. The amplified sound will be for announcements and light music during the walk.
