BACKGROUND

David Pierce, event coordinator of the Denton Day of the Dead Festival, requests an exception to the noise ordinance for amplified sound, not to exceed 75 dba, for the Denton Day of the Dead Festival held on the corner of Mulberry and Industrial Street on Saturday, October 28, 2017. This is the seventh annual event for the Denton Day of the Dead Festival.
