BACKGROUND

STAR Communities is the nation's leading comprehensive framework and certification program for evaluating local sustainability. STAR was designed to help communities identify, validate, and support implementation of best practices to improve sustainable community conditions. The City of Denton began pursuing STAR Certification in 2016, it is a very comprehensive process that evaluates many area of the community beyond what might traditionally be thought of as Sustainability.

STAR evaluates communities based on outcomes and or actions in the following areas:

Built Environment Equity & Empowerment

Climate & Energy Health & Safety
Economy & Jobs Natural Systems
Education, Arts, & Community Innovation & Process

Currently there are fewer than 70 certified communities across the country, including our neighbors in Plano, Austin, San Antonio, and Houston.

STAR relates to so many of the City Key Focus Areas and Goals, this will be one of the largest collaborative efforts we have undertaken as we work together over the next four years to improve our ranking.
