#### **SUBJECT**

Consider a request by DB Denton for approval of a final plat of Lots 17, 18, 19, and 20 of Block A and Lot 1 of Block B of the Rayzor Ranch Town Center. The approximately 20.75-acre site is generally located on the northwest and southwest corners of the future intersection of Panhandle Drive and Heritage Trail in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (FP17-0023, RRTC – Phase 3 East).

## **BACKGROUND**

The property is zoned Regional Center Commercial Downtown (RCC-D) District and is located within the Rayzor Ranch Overlay District. The purpose of the final plat is to create five lots of record and dedicate right-of-way for future roadway extensions. Each of the lots will have frontage on either Panhandle Drive or Heritage Trail.

#### **OPTIONS**

- 1. Approve as submitted.
- 2. Approve subject to conditions.
- 3. Table item.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

The Development Review Committee recommends approval of this request with the following condition:

1. Civil engineering construction plans must be approved before the plat is filed. If any utility easement locations need to be modified as a result of the final civil engineering construction plans, DRC approval shall be required prior to filing.

#### PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW (Council, Boards, Commissions)

Lots 17, 18, 19, and 20 of Block A were previously part of a preliminary plat approved by the Planning and Zoning Commission on January 25, 2017. Lot 1 of Block B was previously approved as part of a conveyance plat by the Planning and Zoning Commission on February 22, 2017.
