Receive a report, hold a discussion and give staff direction regarding changes with the Department of Development Services and an update of the Denton Development Code rewrite project.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Department of Development Services has undergone numerous changes recently. New leadership challenged outdated methods with a focus on implementing best practices.

Staff has implemented numerous changes through the following actions:

- Reorganization, restructuring and streamlining of processes, departments and divisions which have an impact on development in the City of Denton.
- Comprehensive evaluation of current project submittal inventory with a focus on expediting stalled projects.
- Providing professional staff training and development programs.
- Conducting interviews of both internal and external stakeholders for service delivery expectations.
- A comprehensive survey was sent to 27 other municipalities seeking input on processes, procedures, staffing and fees.
- Improved plan review turnaround times.
- Development of a "One-Stop-Shop" customer service portal to enhance the customer service experience.
- Standard operating procedure development aligned with best practices.
- Elimination of the "Site Plan Permit" and simplified site plan requirements. Eliminated the requirement of including construction plans as a component of the initial site plan review.
- Fresh approach to Denton Development Code rewrite; comprehensive rewrite more closely aligned with minimum State statutory requirements.

### STRATEGIC PLAN RELATIONSHIP

The City of Denton's Strategic Plan is an action-oriented road map that will help the City achieve its vision.
