SUBJECT

Consider a request by the City of Denton for approval of a final plat of the Denton Energy Center Addition. The approximately 172,245-acre site is generally located on the south side of Jim Christal, approximately 2,700 feet west of Masch Branch in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (FP16-0043, Denton Energy Center Addition, Julie Wyatt).

BACKGROUND

The purpose of the final plat is to create one lot of record from an unplatted parcel of land in order to develop the site with Denton Municipal Electric utility infrastructure.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW (Council, Boards, Commissions)

A preliminary plat of the Denton Energy Center Addition was approved by the Planning and Zoning Commission on January 11, 2017 (PP16-0021).
