SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton authorizing an agreement between the City of Denton, Texas and Friends with Benefits for the purpose of expenses for outings for the children at Cumberland Children's Home; providing for the expenditure of funds therefor; and providing for an effective date. BACKGROUND

This Agreement allows for the total expenditure of \$160 from Council Contingency Funds. (Council Member Keely Briggs, \$160.

Key provisions of the Agreement include:

- Funds shall be used by Friends with Benefits for expenses related to outings for the children at Cumberland Children's Home.
- In addition to other reporting requirements, documentation in the form of cancelled checks and/or
 corresponding receipts specifically detailing expenditure of funds for the purpose provided is
 required for reimbursement from these designated funds

FISCAL INFORMATION

Funding for the Agreement will come from Council Contingency Funds.
