#### **SUBJECT**

## **BACKGROUND**

John Warren, a pastor at The Village Church Denton, requests an exception to the noise ordinance for a variance in hours of operation to host an outdoor church service on Sunday, April 8, 2018, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at North Lakes Park. The service will include baptisms, readings, and singing.
