SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, Texas granting the Thin Line Film Festival, pursuant to Section 17-20 of the Code of Ordinances, a noise exception Wednesday, April 18, through Sunday, April 22, 2018; granting an increase in sound levels for an outdoor music festival from 70 to 75 dba and a variance in hours of operation each day from noon until 11 p.m. on the Denton County Courthouse lawn; and providing for an effective date.

BACKGROUND

Michael Fraga, representing operations for the Thin Line Film Festival, requests an exception to the noise ordinance for amplified sound, not to exceed 75 dba, and a variance in hours of operation for amplified sound levels for the Thin Line Film Festival on the Denton County Courthouse lawn Wednesday, April 18, through Sunday, April 22, 2018. This is the eleventh annual event for the Thin Line Film Festival.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW

On March 21, 2017, City Council approved an exception to the noise ordinance for the Thin Line Film Festival.
