SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, Texas granting the Denton Cinco De Mayo Festival, pursuant to Section 17-20 of the Code of Ordinances, a noise exception on Saturday, May 5, 2018, at Quakertown Park; granting an increase in sound levels for an outdoor music festival from 70 to 75 dba from 10 a.m. until 10 p.m.; and providing an effective date.

BACKGROUND

Blanca Govea, chairperson for the Denton Cinco de Mayo Festival, requests an exception to the noise ordinance for amplified sound, not to exceed 75 dba, for the Denton Cinco De Mayo Festival held at Quakertown Park on Saturday, May 5, 2018. This is the 31st annual event for the Denton Cinco De Mayo Festival.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW

On April 18, 2017, City Council approved an exception to the noise ordinance for the Denton Cinco de Mayo Festival.
