SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, Texas, granting the Denton Mud Bug Boil, pursuant to Section 17-20 of the Code of Ordinances, a noise exception on Sunday, May 6, 2018, from noon to 6 p.m. in a private parking lot located at 1121 W. Hickory St.; granting a variance in hours of operation for amplified sound levels for an outdoor event; and providing an effective date.

BACKGROUND

Ryann Reid, Denton Mud Bug Boil organizer, requests an exception to the noise ordinance for a variance in hours of operation for amplified sound levels on Sunday, May 6, 2018, from noon to 6 p.m.

This 22nd annual Denton Mud Bug Boil is a fundraising event that will host live music, a kids play area, and vendors. The stage for this event will be in a parking lot privately owned by New Frontiers.
