

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON, TEXAS, A TEXAS HOME-RULE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR ENGINEERING AND ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN FOR VARIOUS CITY OF DENTON PARKING LOTS; PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS THEREFOR; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE (RFQ 6581-AWARDED TO TEAGUE, NALL, AND PERKINS, INC. IN THE NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$300,050).

WHEREAS, Teague, Nall, and Perkins, Inc., the professional services provider (the “Provider”) set forth in this ordinance is being selected as the most highly qualified on the basis of its demonstrated competence and qualifications to perform the proposed professional services; and

WHEREAS, the fees under the proposed contract are fair and reasonable and are consistent with and not higher than the recommended practices and fees published by the professional associations applicable to the Provider’s profession, and such fees do not exceed the maximum provided by law; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a professional service contract with Teague, Nall, and Perkins, Inc., to provide professional design services for engineering and architectural design for various City of Denton parking lots, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized to expend funds as required by the attached contract.

SECTION 3. The City Council of the City of Denton, Texas expressly delegates the authority to take any actions that may be required or permitted to be performed by the City of Denton under RFQ 6581 for engineering and architectural design for various City of Denton parking lots to the City Manager of the City of Denton, Texas, or his designee.

SECTION 4. The findings in the preamble of this ordinance are incorporated herein by reference.


