AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO ELECT TWO CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS TO PLACES 5 AND 6 AND A MAYOR TO PLACE 7 HELD IN THE CITY OF DENTON ON MAY 5, 2018; DECLARING THAT NO CANDIDATE RECEIVED THE MAJORITY OF VOTES CAST FOR PLACE 5 AND THAT A RUNOFF ELECTION IS ORDERED TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, JUNE 16, 2018; AUTHORIZING RUNOFF ELECTION DAY POLLING LOCATIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

## THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The City Council finds and declares that the May 5, 2018 regular municipal election was duly ordered for the purpose of electing two Council Members to Places 5 and 6, and a Mayor to Place 7; that proper notice of said election was duly given and election officials appointed; that the election was duly held and the returns of the election officials have been delivered to the Council, all in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the Charter and ordinances of the City of Denton.

SECTION 2. The official returns of the election officials having been opened, examined, and canvassed, and the Council hereby finds and declares that 8,422 ballots were cast at the election, and that the votes cast for each place on the Council were as follows:

Candidates in the runoff election for Place 5 will be Aaron Fuzzy Newquist and Deb Armintor.
