The Mews Streets (Pecan, Austin, Cedar, and Walnut) were included in the 2005 Bond Election as Downtown Improvements for a total of \$2,800,000 (Streets and Sidewalks). In August of 2010, the Citizens Advisory Oversight Committee made a recommendation to city council to reallocate a total of \$1.8M to the Hickory Street Grand Project which city council approved in October of 2010. The remainder of the funds were reallocated to the Hickory Street Grand Project in August 2012 to cover increased costs. At this time, there are no plans to provide funding to complete the Mews Streets project.


### **User Engagement**

by Active Users vs. Previous Period






### **Audience Map**
