**SUBJECT**

**BACKGROUND**

This Agreement allows for the total expenditure of \$500 from Council Contingency Funds. (Council Member Joey Hawkins)

Key provisions of the Agreement include:

- Funds shall be used for Dropout Prevention Programs in the Denton Independent School District.
- In addition to other reporting requirements, documentation in the form of cancelled checks and/or corresponding receipts specifically detailing expenditure of funds for the purpose provided is required for reimbursement from these designated funds.

**FISCAL INFORMATION**

Funding for the Agreement will come from Council Contingency Funds.
