Title: Consider adoption of an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to execute a Professional Services Agreement for engineering design services relating to the design, bid phase, and construction services for the PEC-4 Phases 3 and 4 Drainage Improvements project which includes approximately 2,700 linear feet of reinforced concrete box, 2,300 linear feet of waterline relocation and lowering, 1,700 linear feet of sanitary sewer line relocation and adjustment, and pavement repair from West Prairie Street to the beginning of the open channel near the intersection of West Mulberry Street and Bernard Street; providing for the expenditure of funds therefor; and providing an effective date (File 6625 awarded to Freese and Nichols, Inc. in the not-to-exceed amount of \$1,200,000).
