BACKGROUND

This Agreement allows for the total expenditure of \$1500 from Council Contingency Funds. (Council Member Dalton Gregory \$750; and Council Member Kevin Roden \$750).

Key provisions of the Agreement include:

- Funds shall be used by Fred Moore Day Nursery for expenses for the Activity Room.
- In addition to other reporting requirements, documentation in the form of cancelled checks and/or corresponding receipts specifically detailing expenditure of funds for the purpose provided is required for reimbursement from these designated funds.
