### SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton authorizing an agreement between the City of Denton, Texas and Day of the Dead Festival; for the purpose of the 2016 Day of the Dead Festival; authorizing the expenditure of funds; and providing for an effective date. (\$500)

### BACKGROUND

This Agreement allows for the total expenditure of \$500 from Council Contingency Funds. (Council Member Joey Hawkins)

Key provisions of the Agreement include:

- Funds shall be used for expenses for the 2015 Day of the Dead Festival.
- In addition to other reporting requirements, documentation in the form of cancelled checks and/or corresponding receipts specifically detailing expenditure of funds for the purpose provided is required for reimbursement from these designated funds.

### FISCAL INFORMATION

Funding for the Agreement will come from Council Contingency Funds.
