SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton authorizing an agreement between the City of Denton, Texas and Communities in Schools of North Texas for the purpose of Dropout Prevention Programs in Denton Independent School District; authorizing the expenditure of funds; and providing for an effective date. (\$500)

BACKGROUND

This Agreement allows for the total expenditure of \$500 from Council Contingency Funds. (Council Member Joey Hawkins)

Key provisions of the Agreement include:

- Funds shall be used for Dropout Prevention Programs in the Denton Independent School District.
- In addition to other reporting requirements, documentation in the form of cancelled checks and/or corresponding receipts specifically detailing expenditure of funds for the purpose provided is required for reimbursement from these designated funds.

FISCAL INFORMATION

Funding for the Agreement will come from Council Contingency Funds.
