SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton authorizing an agreement between the City of Denton, Texas and Salvation Army for the purpose of Emergency Shelter Services, Food Services, and Social Services; authorizing the expenditure of funds; and providing for an effective date. (\$725)

BACKGROUND

This Agreement allows for the total expenditure of \$725 from Council Contingency Funds. (Council Member Keely Briggs)

Key provisions of the Agreement include:

- Funds shall be used for emergency shelter and food services for the homeless.
- In addition to other reporting requirements, documentation in the form of cancelled checks and/or corresponding receipts specifically detailing expenditure of funds for the purpose provided is required for reimbursement from these designated funds.

FISCAL INFORMATION

Funding for the Agreement will come from Council Contingency Funds.
