### **BACKGROUND**

Each year, the City hires an independent accounting firm to conduct an audit of the City's basic financial statements. The purpose of the audit is to express an opinion as to whether the City's basic financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the City.

The City of Denton has a contract with Pattillo, Brown & Hill L.L.P., to perform audit services for FY 2015-16. These services include an audit of the City's basic financial statements in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards and the performance of a Single Audit, which is an audit of the City's expenditures of State and Federal grant awards.

The purpose of this item is to provide the Audit/Finance Committee with an opportunity to communicate with the audit firm during the beginning of the engagement. John Manning and Nicole Bradshaw with Pattillo, Brown & Hill L.L.P., will be in attendance at the Audit/ Finance Committee meeting to give a presentation and to answer any questions that the Committee may have.
